



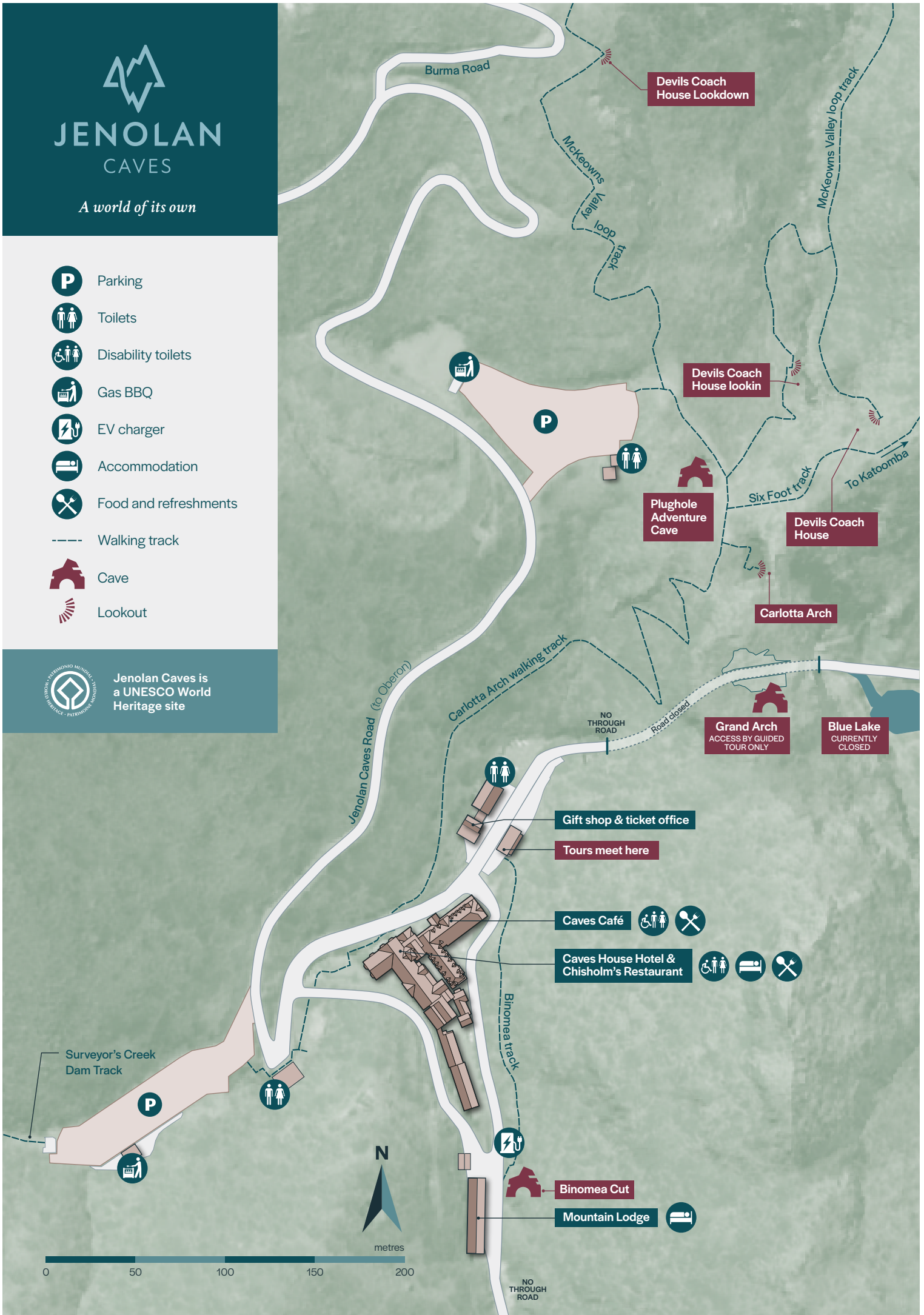

## Discover Jenolan – above ground

### Gift shop, ticket office

If you have not pre-booked your cave tours, pop in to see our friendly staff. After your tour come and say hi to purchase mementos and gifts from our fabulous gift shop.  
**Open daily 9am-4pm**

### Caves café

Drinks, ice cream, alcohol, tea and coffee along with the odd sweet treats. The café won't disappoint. Hot and cold food and drink available.  
**Open daily 9am-4pm**

### Chisholm's Restaurant and Jeremiah's Bar

Edwardian magnificence, fine wine and a warm fire. The restaurant is open for hotel guests and open to the public on **Friday and Saturday nights until 10pm.**

## Jenolan Caves bushwalks

Take plenty of water, sunscreen, and a hat. Keep to paths, leave only footprints, there are no toilets on the tracks.

### BINOOMEA TRACK

At the tour shelter, spot a water dragon or a skink at the waterfall before heading up the stairs to the Binoomea Cut. A short lovely walk with views of Cave House and some beautiful wildlife. Keep an eye out for wallabies, lyrebirds and wildflowers blooming throughout the year.

**Length: 300m return**

**Time: 15 min**

**Difficulty: moderate (grade 2)**

### CARLOTTA ARCH WALK

Start across from Caves House, take the path uphill to Carlotta Arch at the top you'll see stunning scenery, geology and views of the hotel. Keep an eye out for lyrebirds and wallabies. Blue Lake is currently out-of-bounds, but you can see it from Carlotta Arch. In wet weather the path can become slippery.

**Length: 1km round trip**

**Time: 45 minutes return**

**Difficulty: moderate (grade 3)**

### DEVILS COACH HOUSE LOOKDOWN

Start at Carlotta Arch, stay on the main track, uphill to a spectacular lookout. Here you'll see down to the Devils Coach House, McKeown's Valley far below and often Brush-tailed Rock-wallabies.

**Length: 600 metres round trip (from Carlotta Arch)**

**Duration: 30 minutes return**

**Difficulty: moderate (grade 3)**

### MCKEOWNS VALLEY LOOP TRACK

Start at Carlotta Arch, stay on the main track. Turn right down the marked trail. At the valley floor, head right to the Coach House (return trip) or left along the dry creek to the Playing Field and old Brush-tailed Rock-wallaby enclosure. To return, follow the fire trail to Burma Road, continue down the McKeowns Valley loop track past Devils Coach House lookout before heading back towards Caves House.

**Length: 6km round trip**

**Duration: 2 hours return**

**Difficulty: moderate (grade 3)**

### SURVEYOR'S CREEK DAM TRACK

This short but slightly more rugged track takes you from Carpark 1 along Surveyor's Creek to one of the 3 dams on site. Follow the track uphill and enjoy the local wildflowers on the way, while keeping an eye out for our local platypus swimming in the creek or a wallaby watching you from the opposite slope.

**Length: 600m round trip**

**Time: 25 min return**

**Difficulty: moderate (grade 3)**

### SIX FOOT TRACK

The Six-Foot Track ends at Caves House. Challenging but rewarding, a 3 day hike from Katoomba winding through Kanangra Boyd National Park and state forests. Stay with us, but arrange transport from Jenolan as there is no public transport.

**Length: 46km one way**

**Duration: 3 days**

**Difficulty: hard (grade 4)**
